

# Chicken Emergency Care Kit Checklist

*A printable checklist of essential supplies for traditional and homeopathic flock care.*

Traditional Care Items	Homeopathic & Natural Options
Vetericyn or wound spray	Apple cider vinegar (digestive & immune support)
Antibiotic ointment	Garlic (natural antibacterial/antiparasitic)
Poultry vitamins	Calendula salve (wound & skin soothing)
Styptic powder or flour	Arnica (reduce bruising/swelling)
Blue-Kote wound spray	Rescue Remedy (stress calming)
Electrolyte solution (e.g., Hydro Hen)	Oregano oil (natural antimicrobial, small doses)
Corid	
Probiotics	
Blunt-ended scissors	
Tweezers	
Oral dosing syringes	
Petroleum jelly or baby oil	
Heat lamp	
Emergency pen or crate	
Old towel	
Gauze pads & cotton swabs	

**Important Reminders:**

- Check supplies regularly and replace expired items.
- Know your flock's normal behavior to spot illness early.
- First aid kits are supportive only—always consult a poultry vet for serious issues.
